#### **Upper School Uniform Schedule**

FRIDAY	Casual Wear - Jeans/Uniform bottom with a Stonehaven T-shirt/Sweatshirt
SPIRIT DAYS	Approximately once/month. See Spirit Day Guidelines at the bottom of this document.

#### **PE/Athletic Practicum Uniform**

Students who have PE as a practicum will "dress out" for PE at the end of the day and will not need to change back into uniforms.

T-SHIRTS	LE Gray PE shirt with Stonehaven logo or any Stonehaven t-shirt
SHORTS	Any modest black, gray, or navy athletic shorts or Land's End Navy Mesh Shorts
PANTS	Black or navy sweatpants/athletic pants or Land's End Navy Athletic Pants.
SHOES/SOCKS	Athletic sneakers and socks. Must be rubber-soled and suitable for athletic activity.

#### Daily Wear: 7th - 12th Grade Girls

BOTTOMS	LE Khaki or Navy skirt, shorts, or pants. Skirt/short length must be 3" above the knee or longer. Must be worn with privacy shorts (can be purchased anywhere)
	*Approved alternative: Old Navy Boot-Cut Pants Uniform Pants (color: Rolled Oats)

TOPS	LE Navy, Light Blue, Gray, or White Short Sleeve or Long Sleeve Polo with Stonehaven logo
SWEATERS /	Optional, but only uniform items can be worn in the classroom.
SWEATSHIRTS	LE Navy cardigan, pullover, vest, sweatshirt, hoodie, or fleece with Stonehaven logo
SOCKS purchase anywhere	Solid white or navy socks, knee socks, or tights. Leggings are not permitted.
SHOES purchase anywhere	<ul> <li>Solid color Brown, Navy or Black leather or suede shoes (Mary Jane, Saddle Oxford, Merrells, Sperry, Bucs or Loafers.)</li> <li>Or</li> <li>Sneakers that rest at or below the ankle and which are predominantly <b>one</b> color: White, Black, Navy, or Gray.</li> <li>Alternate color <b>must</b> also be White, Black, Navy or Gray. For example, a navy shoe with a white stripe is acceptable. A navy shoe with red on the back is not acceptable.</li> <li>No heels, boots, or high tops. Laces should also be one color.</li> </ul>
<b>BELTS</b> purchase anywhere	If an item has belt loops, a belt must be worn. Black or brown leather only.

SWEATERS/	REQUIRED in chapel. Navy cardigan, pullover, or vest with Stonehaven logo. Sweatshirts
	and fleece jackets are not permitted in chapel but may be worn in the classroom. Hoodies
SWEATSHIRTS	are not permitted.
PRIVACY SHORTS	Navy or Black Bike Shorts (to be worn under skirt and not visible). Must be solid, no

SOCKS	Solid Navy Flat Knit or Opaque Knee Socks or Solid Navy Tights. Patterns are allowed
purchase anywhere	(i.e., cable knit).

SHOES	Solid color Brown, Navy or Black leather or suede shoes (Mary Jane, Saddle Oxford,

SHORTS/PANTS	LE Khaki or Navy shorts or pants *Approved alternative: Old Navy Built-In Flex Straight Uniform Shorts/Pants (color: Shore Enough)
SHIRTS	LE Navy, Light Blue, Gray, or White Short Sleeve or Long Sleeve Polo with Stonehaven logo

SWEATERS /	Optional, but only uniform items can be worn in the classroom.
SWEATSHIRTS	Navy cardigan, pullover, vest, sweatshirt, hoodie, or fleece with Stonehaven logo
SHOES	Black, Brown, or Navy leather or suede shoes (Bucs, Merrells, Sperry, or Loafers)

	Sneakers that rest at or below the ankle which are predominantly <b>one</b> color: White, Black, Navy, or Gray. Alternate color <b>must</b> also be White, Black, Navy or Gray. For example, a navy shoe with a white stripe is acceptable. A white shoe with red on the back is not acceptable.

SOCKS purchase anywhere	White, tan, black, or navy solid color socks.

## **Required Chapel Uniform: 7th - 12th Grade Boys**

TOP and BOTTOM	LE Gray Slacks and White Short Sleeve or Long Sleeve Oxford Shirt with S Logo
TIE	LE Striped or Navy Tie, other solid navy ties with approval
BLAZER	REQUIRED in chapel. Lands' End Navy Blazer (no logo required).
SWEATERS	Sweaters, sweatshirts, and fleece jackets are not permitted in chapel but may be worn in the
	classroom. Hoodies are not permitted.
SOCKS purchase anywhere	Black or Navy Dress Socks
	No White Socks on Chapel Day
SHOES purchase anywhere	Black, Brown, or Navy leather or suede shoes (Bucs, Merrells, Sperry, or Loafers)
	No boots or high tops.
<b>BELTS</b> purchase anywhere	Required. Black or brown leather only.

\*Chapel wear is permitted any day, but required on Chapel Day (Wednesdays).

## **Stonehaven Uniform Policy Guidelines**

Shirts	Shirts are to be tucked in at all times. "Blousing" of shirts is not permitted. Approved sweatshirts and sweaters must be worn with a collared uniform shirt underneath. Long sleeve t-shirts are not permitted under the uniform polo. Short-sleeve undershirts must be white.
Coats	Winter coats may be purchased from any store but must be navy, black, or charcoal, solid color. No characters, logos, or designs permitted. Coats, including letterman jackets, are not to be worn inside the building.

Hair Accessories	Hair accessories should be uniform colors or neutral/natural and not distracting.
Casual Wear Guidelines	<ul> <li>On designated Casual Wear days, students may wear a Stonehaven t-shirt or Uniform Polo with jeans.</li> <li>Jeans (blue, black, white) must have no rips, tears or holes.</li> <li>Uniform bottoms are also permitted (khaki pants, shorts, skirts).</li> <li>Shorts must meet the "fingertip" test for length.</li> <li>No sweatpants, joggers, or leggings.</li> <li>Leggings may only be worn under a skirt or shorts; no leggings as pants. When leggings are worn under a skirt or shorts, the top layer must still meet the "fingertip" test for length.</li> </ul>
Stonehaven Spirit Day Guidelines	<ul> <li>On designated Spirit Days (generally once/month), students may wear an official Stonehaven Spirit Shirt (available for purchase from the school office) or Stonehaven Uniform Polo or Stonehaven t-shirt.</li> <li>Students may wear uniform bottoms or jeans with no holes, tears, stains, logos, or characters.</li> <li>Shorts must meet the "fingertip" test for length.</li> <li>No sweatpants, joggers, or leggings.</li> <li>House colors are permitted only on days designated as such. House colors are not a part of Spirit Wear, but should follow Spirit Wear guidelines for modesty</li> <li>Shoes: should be sufficient for outdoor activity (no sandals, flip flops, crocs, heels).</li> </ul>
Free Dress Day Guidelines	<ul> <li>Free Dress Days will occur periodically in 7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grades. The privilege of free dress participation will be earned by each student through uniform compliance.</li> <li>Girls: <ul> <li>Neat and respectable shirts, blouses, or dresses.</li> <li>Nothing skintight or overly revealing.</li> <li>No sleeveless tops, tank tops, or crop tops</li> <li>Neat and respectable pants, jeans, skirts, or shorts</li> <li>No tight-fitting pants (leggings), jeans, or shorts.</li> <li>Skirts or shorts need to be comparable in length to uniform daily wear skirts and shorts.</li> <li>Clothing may not have holes, fraying, or inappropriate/offensive slogans.</li> </ul> </li> <li>Boys: <ul> <li>Neat and respectable shirts, pants or shorts.</li> <li>Shorts need to be comparable in length to uniform daily wear shorts.</li> <li>No low-waisted, tight-fitting, oversized or sagging jeans, pants, or shorts.</li> <li>Shorts need to be comparable in length to uniform daily wear shorts.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
General Dress Code Guidelines	<ul> <li>Shoes: should be sufficient for outdoor activity.</li> <li>All uniform items should contain the student's name.</li> <li>Clothing may be selected to permit reasonable growing room, but extreme over-sizing is not permitted.</li> <li>Tattoos are not permitted.</li> </ul>

	<ul> <li>Girls: modest jewelry is allowed (i.e., gold/silver loop earrings, gold/silver necklaces or bracelets.)</li> <li>Boys: may wear tasteful necklaces that are not visible. Boys may not wear earrings. Piercings are not permitted on boys.</li> <li>Excessive make-up is not permitted.</li> <li>Unnaturally colored/dyed (i.e., blue) hair is not permitted.</li> <li>Hair must be neatly groomed. Boys' hair must be short enough that it remains off the collar and out of the eyes.</li> <li>Any outlandish or distracting clothing, jewelry, make-up, hairstyle or appearance will not be permitted.</li> <li>Student apparel and school gear (e.g. backpacks, lunch containers, notebooks, etc.) shall not display any commercial slogans, product promotions, celebrity representations, or any pictures/cartoons of commercial characters.</li> </ul>
Enforcement	Please see the Student-Parent Handbook for more information about the rationale for uniforms and dress codes. The school faculty and administration will enforce the Uniform and Dress Code Policy. Students not complying with the Uniform and Dress Code Policy will be required to rectify their appearance immediately. Cheerful, consistent compliance is expected. Students who violate the Uniform and Dress Code Policy, either by action or by challenging and rebellious attitudes, will be subject to disciplinary actions. If repeated or extreme violations occur, parents will be contacted to correct the violation immediately. Students will not be permitted on field trips without proper uniform attire.
