


2nd Grade Summer Reading List

Required Reading: Good Dog, Carl by Alexandra Day



This is a wordless book that uses only pictures to tell the story. It allows the reader to use the pictures in the book and his/her imagination to create the storyline which includes a beginning, middle, and end. The story should match what is happening in the pictures.

For ease, use sticky notes on the appropriate pages in the wordless book to help organize sentences. Once this is done, have your child write their short story in simple paragraph form.
