## **Stonehaven Uniform Policy Guidelines**

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Shirts	Shirts are to be tucked in at all times. "Blousing" of shirts is not permitted. Approved sweatshirts and sweaters must be worn with a collared uniform shirt underneath. Long sleeve t-shirts are not permitted under the uniform polo. Short-sleeve undershirts must be white.
Coats	Winter coats may be purchased from any store but must be navy, black, white, light grey, or charcoal, solid color. No denim, characters, logos, or designs permitted. Coats, including letterman jackets, are not to be worn inside the building.
Hair Accessories	Hair accessories should be uniform colors or neutral/natural and not distracting.
Casual Wear Guidelines	On designated Casual Wear days, students may wear a Stonehaven t-shirt or Uniform Polo with jeans.  Leans (blue black white) must be use to give to give the less.

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#### Girls:

- Neat and respectable shirts, blouses, or dresses.
- Nothing skintight or overly revealing.
- No sleeveless tops, tank tops, or crop tops
- Neat and respectable pants, jeans, skirts, or shorts
- No tight-fitting pants (leggings), jeans, or shorts.
- Skirts or shorts need to be comparable in length to uniform daily wear skirts and shorts.
- Clothing may not have holes, fraying, or inappropriate/offensive slogans.
- Shoes: should be sufficient for outdoor activity.

#### **Boys:**

- Neat and respectable shirts, pants or shorts.
- No low-waisted, tight-fitting, oversized or sagging jeans, pants, or shorts.
- Shorts need to be comparable in length to uniform daily wear shorts.
- No tank tops or sleeveless shirts.
- Clothing may not have holes, fraying, or inappropriate/offensive slogans.
- Shoes: should be sufficient for outdoor activity.

### General Dress Code Guidelines

- All uniform items should contain the student's name.
- Clothing may be selected to permit reasonable growing room, but extreme over-sizing is not permitted.
- Tattoos are not permitted.
- Girls: modest jewelry is allowed (i.e., gold/silver loop earrings, gold/silver necklaces or bracelets.)
- Boys: may wear tasteful necklaces that are not visible. Boys may not wear earrings. Piercings are not permitted on boys.
- Excessive make-up is not permitted.
- Unnaturally colored/dyed (i.e., blue) hair is not permitted.
- Hair must be neatly groomed. Boys' hair must be short enough that it remains off the collar and out of the eyes.
- Any outlandish or distracting clothing, jewelry, make-up, hairstyle or appearance will not be permitted.
- Student apparel and school gear (e.g. backpacks, lunch containers, notebooks, etc.) shall not display any commercial slogans, product promotions, celebrity representations, or any pictures/cartoons of commercial characters.

### **Enforcement**

Please see the Student-Parent Handbook for more information about the rationale for uniforms and dress codes.

The school faculty and administration will enforce the Uniform and Dress Code Policy. Students not complying with the Uniform and Dress Code Policy will be required to rectify their appearance immediately. Cheerful, consistent compliance is expected. Students who violate the Uniform and Dress Code Policy, either by action or by challenging and rebellious attitudes, will be subject to disciplinary actions. If repeated or extreme violations occur, parents will be contacted to correct the violation immediately. Students will not be permitted on field trips without proper uniform attire.
