### Personal Supplies

4 – composition books (*Non-perforated 100 sheets; college ruled; **different colors***)  
1 - composition book with graph paper (*Non-perforated 100 sheets; college ruled*)  
2 - .5 inch plastic binder (1 white, 1 black)  
8 – tab dividers  
2 – two-pocket, three-prong vinyl folder  
2 – two-pocket, three-hole punch vinyl folder (to go in binder)  
1 – pair of scissors  
1- soft pencil case  
1 - locker shelf (foldable or retractable)  
ESV Bible\*  
soft lunch box\*\*  
water bottle (must have a leak-proof straw, no gatorade squirt bottles)\*\*

### Community (Shared) Supplies
